

SELECT PERFORMER PROGRAM  
LAMB REPORT WORKSHEET INSTRUCTIONS

- **Lamb ID** – Enter a personal ID number. This must correspond to the eartag/tattoo.
- **Dam ID** --
  - **ACR Registered** – Use the ACR registration number or personal ID. The online LAMB REPORT spreadsheet will give you a drop-down list of the ewes you currently own, and you may select from it.
  - **Other** – If the ewe is registered but you no longer or never owned it, make a note on the back of this Worksheet. You will be able to enter the ewe’s ACR registration number in the online spreadsheet.
- **Dam Age** – Give the age of the dam at the time of lambing. Enter **1** year old, **2** years old, **3-6** years old or **7+** years old. This is used to calculate the adjusted weights of the lambs.
- **Sire ID** –
  - **ACR Registered** – Use the ACR registration number or personal ID. The online LAMB REPORT spreadsheet will give you a drop-down list of the rams you currently own, and you may select from it.
  - **Other** – – If the ram is registered but you no longer or never owned it, make a note on the back of this Worksheet. You will be able to enter the ram’s ACR registration number in the online spreadsheet.
- **Birth Date** – Enter the lamb’s birth date in **mm/dd/yyyy** format.

**Birth Wgt – Birth Weight** - Enter the lamb’s birth weight – taken as soon after birth as possible. You may use any weight measure you’d like (lbs, kg, etc) but be sure to *be consistent* throughout *all* the weights entered for *this* animal, *all* animals in this year’s report and *all other years*. Reports do not show which unit is in use. You will have to keep track of that.
- **B / Birth Type** – Enter **1** for Single, **2** for Twin, **3** for Triplet, etc.
- **CR / Color** – Enter **W** if the animal is white fleeced with no known natural colored heritage. Enter **W/N** if the animal is white fleeced with natural colored heritage. Enter **N** if the animal has a natural colored fleece.
- **SEX** – Enter **R** for Ram, **E** for Ewe, **A** for Abortion
- **C / Conception** –
  - Enter **A** for lambs conceived within the first 21 days of exposure to the ram.
  - Enter **B** for lambs conceived during days 22-38 of exposure to the ram.
  - Enter **C** for lambs conceived after 38 days.
- **L / Live** – Enter **A** for born alive. Enter **D** for born dead.
- **R / Reared** – Enter **1** for raised as a single. Enter **2** for raised as a twin. Enter **3** for raised as a triplet, etc.

- **Date 1/Weight 1** – Use this for age ranges from 30-75 days. The spreadsheet will calculate the adjusted weight at 60 days. If the age is more than 75 days, the adjusted weight will be calculated based on the following:
  - 76-100 days of age = 90-day adjusted weight.
  - 101-135 days of age = 120 -day adjusted weight.
  - 136+ days of age = 150-day adjusted weight.

The ADJ WT Header will show the adjusted weight days for the actual age of the lamb at weighing.

- **Date 2/Weight 2** – Follow instructions for Date 1/Weight 1. Date 2/Weight 2 will show :
  - Age (in days)
  - Average Daily Gain
  - XX\*-day Adjusted Weight

Fields with insufficient data to calculate the result will show “—”.

For the Adjusted Weight to display, all of the following fields must have an entry:

- Dam Age (in years)
- Birth Date
- Birth Weight
- Birth Type
- Sex
- Live (entry must be A or blank)
- Reared
- Date 2
- Weight 2

\*The adjusted weight day will be calculated using the lamb age (in days) at weighing.

NOTE: If you would like to enter more than 2 dates and weights to be calculated, use the back of the Worksheet to record your entries. You will be able to enter up to 4 dates and weights for calculation in the spreadsheet online.

- **SP/ Select Performer** – Enter a check mark to indicate which lambs you have chosen for Select Performer (SP) registration. These lambs must exhibit traits as outlined in the ACR Breed Standard. In addition, ram lambs must be of multiple birth, be conceived within the first 21 days of exposure to the ram and be selected from the top 30% of the ram lamb crop. Ewe lambs must have been conceived within the first 38 days of exposure to the sire and be selected from the top 70% of the ewe lamb crop. Lambs that have not been selected for SP registration but meet the criteria for registration in ACR may be registered in the conventional way. The online Lamb Report will allow you to select the REG box to indicate that.
