

THE AMERICAN COOPWORTH REGISTRY
Registration Form Instructions

Please use these color definitions when completing the Registration Form.

W — White fleeced animal with no known natural colored heritage
W/N — White fleeced animal with natural colored heritage
N — Animal with natural colored fleece

Please print clearly in ink and check your work for accuracy.

1. **Sex** - Use R for ram and E for ewe.
2. **Private ID** - This is the ID you use personally and usually refers to the animal's eartag or tattoo.
3. **Birth Date** - Give the month, day and year.
4. **Birth Type** - Circle S for single, Tw for twin or Tr for triplet.. If the animal is from a larger litter, please write in the number born, e.g. a quadruplet would be indicated by "4".
5. **Color** - Using the definitions above, circle one.
6. **Sire Information** - Give the name/private ID, the ACR Registration number and, using the definitions above, circle the color of the sire.
7. **Dam Information** - Give the name/private ID, the ACR Registration number and, using the definitions above, circle the color of the dam.
8. **PD** - This refers to Performance Designation. Check this box to register animals that meet PD standards as outlined in the ACR By-laws. When registering PD lambs, send the completed Registration Form and a Lamb Report to the ACR Secretary. Registration certificates for PD lambs cannot be issued by the Registrar until the Lamb Report has been approved by the ACR Secretary.
9. **Transfers** - Use this when ownership of the animal changes. Give the date sold and the name and address of the new owner.

Breeder and Owner - The "Owner" is the owner of the dam at the time of lambing. The "Breeder" is the owner of the dam at the time of breeding. The Registration Form must be signed by the Owner. If the Breeder is someone other than the Owner, the Breeder must be listed but a signature is not required. When registering animals from different Breeders, please use a separate form for each Breeder.

Ram Lease - When registering lambs sired by a ram that did not belong to you at the time of breeding or resulting from the purchase of bred ewes, this form must be completed and signed by the owner of the ram. The form is available at www.AmericanCoopworthRegistry.org, from the ACR Secretary or the Registrar.

Certificate of AI Breeding - This form, completed and signed by the AI Technician, must accompany the Registration Form when registering lambs resulting from an AI procedure. Also attach AI ram's pedigree if available. The form is available at www.AmericanCoopworthRegistry.org, from the ACR Secretary or the Registrar.
